**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20**

**“DIRECTING THE CONCERN LGU OFFICES OF ANDA, PANGASINAN FOR THE FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE No. 01-2019, KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE TRAFFIC CODE OF ANDA, PANGASINAN AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF”**

**WHEREAS**, Art. 87 (2) of RA 8160 provides among others that the Municipal Mayor, As the Chief Executive of the Municipal Government, shall enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the municipality and the exercise of its corporate powers provided in Rule IX of these rules;

**WHEREAS**, vehicular traffic in this Municipality of Anda particularly along its major thoroughfares has greatly worsened in recent years as a result of the increasing population, the economic and business boom, and the concomitant increase in the number of motor vehicles;

**WHEREAS**, after due public consultation, the Sangguniang Bayan of Anda, Pangasinan submitted the proposed Ordinance No. 1-2019 to Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and to Section 447 (2) (I) (iii), (5) (V) and (VI) of RA 7160;

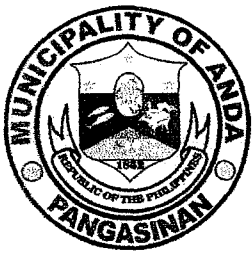
**NOW THEREFORE, I, JOGANIE C. RARANG**, Municipal Mayor of Anda, Pangasinan, by virtue of powers vested in me by law, do hereby ordain;

**Section 1. Composition of Traffic Management Council.**

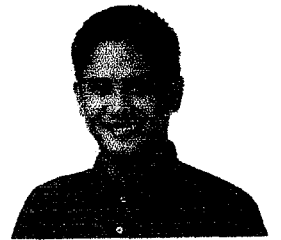

**Section 2. Power, Functions and Duties of Traffic Management Council.**

1. Formulate Operational Traffic Plans and shall approved by the Sangguniang Bayan;
2. Formulate and proposed comprehensive, traffic system which subject for the approval of the Sangguniang Bayan by way of an ordinance;
3. Formulate and proposed scientifically traffic management program to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval.
4. Formulate and conduct Enhancement programs for the traffic enforcers;
5. Conduct Information Program and Campaign for the Public for the public so that everybody will obey the traffic ordinance;
6. Issue identification cards to all traffic enforcers and cancellation the same with legal caused;

7. Prepare and proposed the annual budgetary requirements for the efficient operation of the TMC for the effective implementation of this ordinance and shall be incorporated under the Office of the Mayor as the implementing office;
8. Recruit and hire traffic enforcers and likewise, dismissed the same with legal caused. Creation of Traffic and Parking Management Office or other agency or body for the implementation of traffic rules and regulation;
9. Provision of the Traffic Citation Ticket;
10. Update and propose amendments of this Traffic Code to the Sangguniang Bayan if it is deem necessary;
11. Other powers, functions and duties as maybe prescribed by laws or ordinance.

**Section 3.** The Traffic Management Council shall also act as Grievance Committee with jurisdiction over any and all complaints against the traffic enforcers, not otherwise under the jurisdiction of Peoples Law Enforcement Board (PLEB).

**Section 4.** The Traffic Management Council shall conduct regular meeting every last Monday of the month and or as deem required and necessary. Provided, that, the time and place of meeting shall be fixed by the TMC. Provided, However, that on the first meeting the TMC shall come up with their budgetary requirements Proposal for their administration and operations and for the effective implementation of this ordinance. Provided, Further, that the budgetary requirements proposal shall no exceed Php 400,000.00 on the first year of its implementation and in the succeeding years the TMC shall determine the amount required for the operations and administration of the TMC and incorporated under the Office of the Mayor and shall be appropriated annually and thereafter in the Annual Budget of the Municipality.

**Section 5. Effectivity.**

This order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof, shall remain in full force and effect until revoke in writing by the undersigned.
