**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27**  
**Series of 2019**

**“IMPLEMENTING A TEMPORARY TOTAL BAN ON THE ENTRY OF ALL LIVE SWINE/PIGS INTO THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANDA, PANGASINAN”**

**WHEREAS**, sometime in August 2019, there were incident reports of unusual swine mortality in the Provinces of Rizal and Bulacan from suspected hog diseases;

**WHEREAS**, a temporary ban on entry of swine/pigs in the Province of Pangasinan from Rizal and Bulacan has been ordered via the issuance of the Executive Order No. 0076-2019 and Executive Order No. 0080-2019;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agriculture Secretary William Dar confirmed thru DA-CMTF Bulletin No. 5 posted on September 9, 2019 that the results of the confirmatory Polymerase Chain Reaction test are **African Swine Fever positive**;

**WHEREAS**, there is an urgent need for a wider and more stringent ban on entry of swine/pigs in the Province of Pangasinan to safeguard its swine industry as well as to protect the general public from ill effects of African Swine Fever;

**WHEREAS**, the General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOGANIE C. RARANG**, Mayor of the Municipality of Anda Pangasinan, Philippines, do hereby order a **temporary total prohibition on the entry of all swine/pigs into the Municipality of Anda** until such a time a declaration is made by the Bureau of Animal Industry of the assurance of the safety in the swine industry. Office of the Provincial Agriculturist (OPAG), Market Supervisor, Sanitary Inspector, MAFC, and PNP-Anda are hereby deputized to cause the installation of quarantine checkpoints in the possible entry points of swine shippers from the nearby towns and other strategic roadlines.

Further, in order to ensure safety of our constituents and our swine industry, all barangay officials are directed to strengthen biosafety, hygiene and sanitation standards and secure necessary permit before slaughtering the pigs in their respective area of jurisdiction.

This order shall effect immediately.
